As that may prevent z2 from starting up, and as z2 is the only process that legitimately access the GitCR Git repo, we can lock externally using a safe java.nio.channels.FileLock based mechanism. Acceptance Criteria <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lock fetch on the git repo in the gitcr using LockingRevFile.• If finding a .git/index.lock at fetch time, delete it. | | | |
