Description

Found changed subversion UUID for repo. Will run full scan: environment/acsaRepository.

It happens quite often that the SVNCR thinks the UUID has changed upon a sync. But the repo hasn't changed at all. I could see in the debugger that

```
current.getUUID()
```

delivers null.
